### Breck's Last Game – Primary and secondary resources available

We are delighted to inform you that, after months of consultation, Breck's Last Game, a major new film aimed at protecting children from online grooming, along with a comprehensive resource pack, is now available for use in your school.

The online pack includes lesson plans which have been developed with the support of the Breck Foundation. We recommend whole school delivery in KS3 and KS4 lessons.

Many of you were involved in the consultation process which has helped to shape the final product – thanks to everybody who gave their time and input. Please be aware that feedback from practitioners, key organisations and partner agencies has resulted in two versions of the film being made – one which includes a short scene featuring a knife and one which doesn't. It is up to you and your staff to decide which version is most appropriate for your pupils.

Therefore, in the pack, contained in the link below, you will find:

- Confidential links to two versions of Breck's Last Game these are non-downloadable and strictly for use in schools only they are not for further dissemination as the film won't be released online until early 2019, to ensure the film is first shown to students in controlled, supportive environments.
- A **parent presentation** we recommend you invite parents to view the film in advance of it being shown to children, so they can give permission for their child to see it and be encouraged to share the film's key messages with their children.

Three lesson plans and accompanying resources for each one.

- A Breck Foundation flyer for students.
- A **fact sheet** for parents.
- **Four films** from Lorin LaFave, Breck Bednar's mother telling Breck's story, explaining the importance of the project, one for parents and one for teachers.
